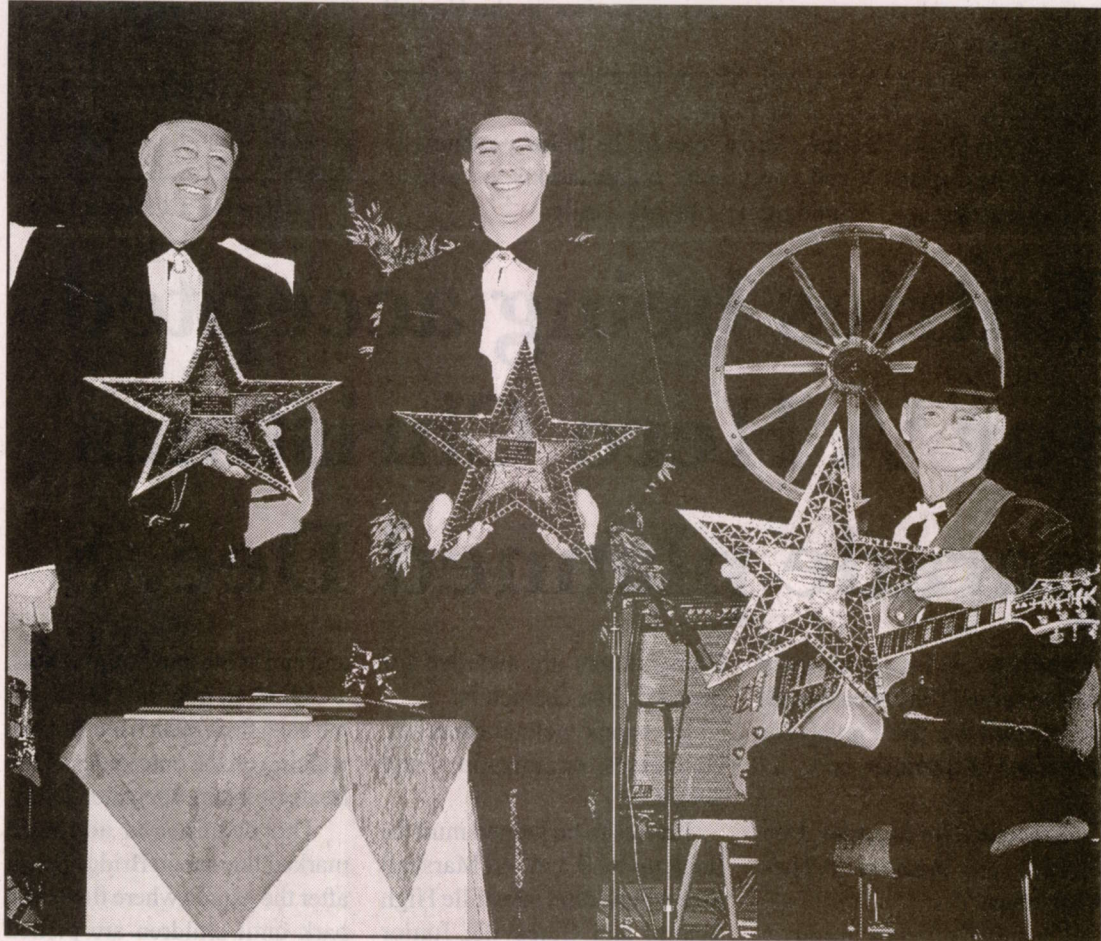




How does he do that?
